

PING PONG

A ping pong match consists of a number of games, 3 or 5 you can choose yourselves. Whoever wins the most games has won the match. This doesn't mean that all 3 or 5 games have to be played. At 5 games if someone already won the first three the game is won.

In a game it is about whoever reaches 11 or 21 points first. There must be a difference of at least 2 points. So with 11 against 10 points the game is not over yet. In such a position the play continues until there is a difference of at least two points.

The lottery determines who may start serving. This is usually done by letting the opponent choose in which hand the ball is, both hands are kept under the table. The winner gets to start. After serving twice the service goes to the opponent. At 21 points it changes after 5 serves.

DOUBLES

There are a few different rules in doubles. For example, when serving the ball must first enter one's own right half court and then diagonally into the right half of the opponent (seen from opponents' side). In double the players take turns serving. After two serves the players of the teams change places so the teammate becomes the server in the next serve round. After each game server and receiver switch so one server now serves a different opponent.

THE END OF THE GAME

The player of team that reaches 11 or 21 points wins the game. The player or team first to win 3 or 5 games is the winner. How many games you play is up to you!
